Being a By-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to Amend By-law 172-13, a by-law to regulate dogs in the City of Cambridge pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001.

WHEREAS the City of Cambridge has a By-law 172-13 to regulate dogs in the City;

AND WHEREAS By-law 172-13 requires a modification to allow for enforcement of persistent dog barking;

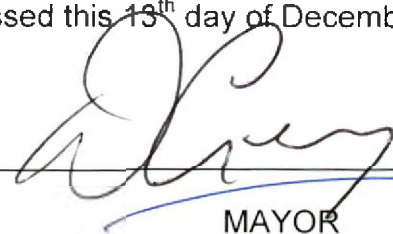
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

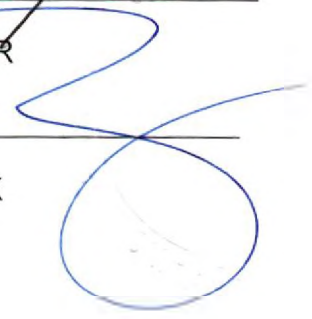
1. THAT Section 6.9 of By-law 172-13 is amended by deleting the word "public" in the second line and by deleting paragraph (a) and replacing it with the following:

"(a) persistent barking or howling in a manner that disturbs or is likely to disturb the peace, quiet, rest, enjoyment or comfort of any person in a dwelling unit, including an apartment, or any person in the vicinity of the barking and/or howling."
2. THAT this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
