

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRAMAHE
BY-LAW NO. BL-2025-57

Being a By-law to amend By-law 2007-31, for the Regulation of Traffic in the Township of Cramahe.

Whereas the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, Section 11(3) states Municipalities may pass By-Laws to regulate highways, including parking and traffic on highways; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Cramahe considers it advisable to enact and update the consolidated Regulation of Traffic By-Law; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Cramahe deems it expedient to pass a By-Law to regulate traffic within the Township; and

Whereas section 137 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, provides for the Council of a municipality may by By-Law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction; and

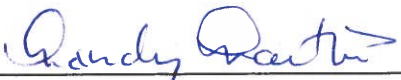
Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Cramahe hereby enacts as follows:

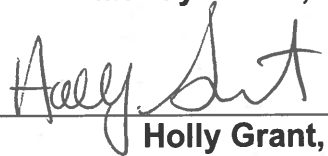
1. **That** Schedule 6 Regulating Traffic - Stop Streets/Highways be updated to include the following:

No.	Column 1 Intersection	Column 2 Facing Traffic	Column 3 Street/Highway
251.	Purdy Road and Little Lake Road	East Bound	Purdy Road

2. **That** the penalties provided for in Section 214 (1) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, shall apply to offences against this By-Law.
3. **That** this By-Law shall be deemed to be in force and effect the date of its passing.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 28th day of October 2025.
