

Appendix A: Designated Disposal List – Common School Generated Waste Examples

Secondary Science – Inorganic	Yes			Store in provided labelled disposal containers within chemical prep room. Include with hazardous waste pick up.
Secondary Science - Organic	Yes			Store in provided labelled disposal container within flammable storage cabinet. Include with hazardous waste pick up.
Secondary Science – General (Household materials)		Yes		Regular garbage disposal or flush with large amount of water down drain
Secondary Science – Specimen and Preserving Fluid Waste	Yes			Store in provided labelled pail within the prep room. Include with hazardous waste pick up.
Secondary Technology – Waste Oil	Yes			H&S will coordinate bi-annual pump out of all waste storage tanks.
Secondary Technology – Solvents, Paints and Stains	Yes			Store in original container within flammable cabinet. Include with hazardous waste pick up.
Secondary Technology – Oil Filters	Yes			Store separately in pail. Include with hazardous waste pick up.
Secondary Technology – Oily Rags	Yes			Store separately in provided metal pail. Include with hazardous waste pick up.
Secondary Art Supplies (e.g. paint, glazes)	Yes			Store in original containers within flammable cabinet. Include with hazardous waste pick up.
Facilities Services – Expired Cleaning Supplies	Yes			Contact chemical supplier for pick up

Facilities Services – Fluorescent Bulbs			Yes	Submit maintenance work order for pick up
Facilities Services – leftover paint from previous maintenance project	Yes			Issue work order for pick up Note: empty cans are not hazardous waste Note: residential paint will not be picked up
eWaste – IT Assets	Yes			If in good condition, store in a separate bin, in a cool dry location. Submit IT Service Request (Asset Recovery) for pickup as needed.
Batteries - alkaline	Yes			If in good condition, store in a separate bin, in a cool dry location. Submit IT Service Request (Asset Recovery) for pickup as needed.
Batteries – lithium, lithium-Ion, nickel cadmium	Yes			If in good condition, store in a separate bin, in a cool dry location. Cover terminal ends with clear tape or bag separately. Submit IT Service Request (Asset Recovery) for pickup as needed.
Medical Waste (e.g. sharps)	Yes			Contact Health and Safety
Bio-waste (e.g. soiled disposable diapers)		Yes		Put in separate plastic bag and place in regular garbage until disposal.
Copier cartridges and toner			Yes	Return to vendor. Contact Purchasing for assistance.

Please note, not all hazardous wastes are identified within this list. If you are unsure of the proper disposal method, contact Health and Safety for guidance.

If hazardous waste items are not in good condition and showing signs of deterioration or leaking contact Health and Safety immediately for assistance.
