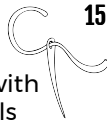

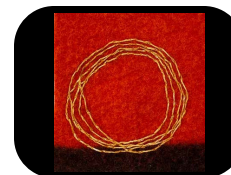
FULL CIRCLE: ART SHOW & EVENTS WITH BRIAN NICHOLS
