- Radios and stereos (including aftermarket vehicle stereos)

- Handheld point-of-sale devices or terminals

- Audio recording equipment, headphones or speakers
- Electronic batteries

Drop Off the Following Hard-to-Recycle Items at RE:Connect

ALL Brand Programs:

Febreze Air and Home Care – Recycle all brands of air and home care products and packaging (trigger heads, pumps, caps, fresheners and cartridge refills, flexible cleaning wipe packaging)

Gillette – Recycle all brands of blades, razors, and plastic packaging

Toms of Maine - Recycle all brands of personal care packaging (toothbrushes, tubes and caps, mouthwash containers and caps, deodorant containers and caps)

Unsmoke Canada – Recycle all brands of Cigarette Waste (butts, filters, tobacco pouches, rolling paper, outer plastic and inner foil)
