

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN

BY-LAW NUMBER 2025-70

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2022-55 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN.

WHEREAS Section 10(1) of the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2001 c. 25*, as amended, empowers municipalities to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

AND WHEREAS the *Highway Traffic Act R.S.O., Bill 26, 1998* provides that municipalities may designate a part of a highway under their jurisdiction as a Community Safety Zone;

AND WHEREAS subsection 425(1) of the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2001 c. 25*, as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws providing that any person who contravenes a by-law of the municipality passed under said Act is guilty of an offence,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Dryden deems it expedient to pass a by-law to provide for the designation of an area as a Community Safety Zone;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Dryden enacts as follows:

1. That the following is added to Definitions:

“Community Safety Zone” means a designated stretch of roadway, recognized under provincial legislation, marked with community safety zone signs allowing the doubling of fines associated with speeding and, through the applicable sections of Bill 65, Safer School Zones Act, 2017.

2. That the following are added to Section 21 – Signs and Traffic Regulations

i) **Community Safety Zones** - Community Safety Zones, as marked in accordance with the *Highway Traffic Act* and designated by this by-law, shall provide for the increase of penalties associated with speeding violations under the *Highway Traffic Act*.

a. A Community Safety Zone is hereby designated beginning at the intersection of the East Leg of Bertha Place at Wice Road for the entirety of Wice Road, up to the East limit of Wice Road. The Community Safety Zone shall remain in effect 24 hours per day, 7 days per week from January 1st to December 31st of every calendar year.

3. That the following is added to Schedule P – Speed Limits:

Street	Speed Limit	Location
Albert Street	40 km/h	From Kirkpatrick Avenue to Casimir Avenue
Casimir Avenue	40 km/h	From Duke Street to Arthur Street

THAT This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.

Enacted and passed this 15th day of December 2025 as witnessed by the Seal of the Corporation and the hands of its proper Officers duly authorized in that behalf.
