I am pleased to confirm that Dryden Fire Service has been registered in the Fire Underwriters Survey's fire insurance grading index as Superior Tanker Shuttle Service (STSS) accredited for Personal Lines Insurance risks. This accreditation came into effect upon completion of testing on August 8th, 2026, and will expire in five years on August 8th, 2031.

Official testing of Dryden Fire Service's water tanker shutting capabilities was conducted on August 8th, 2026. During this test the department demonstrated that it is more than capable of delivering the minimum acceptable fire flow required for personal lines insurance risks, 200 IGPM for 2 hours. This accreditation is an equivalency to the minimum requirements for hydrant protection as set out by the insurance industry and the Fire Underwriters Survey. While insurers are under no obligation to accept this equivalency within their own business practices, the Fire Underwriters Survey strongly recommends that they do so.

A Dwelling Protection Grade score of 3B(S) will now be applied to personal lines insurance risks that are within 5km of a recognized STSS water supply point and within 8km of the following Dryden Fire Service fire stations:

- Dryden Fire Station # 2 – 14378 ON-17, Dryden, ON P8N 2Y4

The Fire Underwriters Survey has provided information on fire protection and risk levels to the insurance industry in Canada since 1883. The Fire Underwriters Survey was previously operated under the auspices of the Insurers Advisory Organization, CGI; however, is now operated by Opta Information Intelligence through Verisk Canada.
