Addendum #2 (Final) - Questions and Answers

Engineering Services – Gordon Road Landfill and Excess Soil Site Designation

1. The RFP states that the proposal submission deadline is August 26, 2026, there is an acceptance period of 90 calendar days (taking up to November 26, 2026), and the Regulatory Submission package(s) for the Closure Plan and Excess Soil designated site registered is due by January 1, 2027. If the full 90-day acceptance period is utilized prior to awarding this project, only one month would remain to complete the deliverables for this project. In addition, there would likely be snow cover present by November, impeding visual observations of site conditions and completion of a topographical survey. Should this occur, is there flexibility to the schedule of deliverables to allow sufficient time to complete the work (also considering the Christmas Break and statutory holidays)?

Response: *The City would like to have this work complete by January 1, 2027. The Excess Soil portion of this work can be focused on first with respect to priority, and the Closure Plan can follow later into the year if required. Any reasonable delays can be discussed with timelines extended as required.*

2. Will a site visit and existing conditions review occur before snow cover is anticipated (i.e., November)?

Response: *The successful proponent can schedule site visits as required to facilitate completion of the project, and the City will support as needed.*

3. Can the City provide the alternative locations for consideration of a potential Excess Soil reuse site or, at the very least, the number of potential reuse sites to be considered?

Response: *The City will provide a list of alternative locations (20+), that could be considered. Gordon Road, operationally, is the preferred location.*

4. Can a virtual meeting occur in lieu of a site visit before closing of this RFP to discuss the project?

Response: *The City is willing to host a Teams Meeting for interested parties to ask further questions. Please reach out to Bill Mundy (bmundy@dryden.ca) for a meeting invite. The meeting will be held on Thursday, August 20 2026, at 9:00 CST.*



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5. Can the deadline for submission be extended by a week?

Response: *The deadline for this RFP is now September 2, 2026, 14:00 local time, Dryden, Ontario.*
