Subject: Decision not to veto August 11, 2026 by-laws

In accordance with section 284.11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (the “Act”), and Ontario Regulation 530/22, despite any procedure by-law, if the head of council is of the opinion that all or part of a by-law could potentially interfere with a prescribed provincial authority, the head of council may provide written notice to the council of the intent to consider vetoing the by-law.

Section 284.11(4)(a)(i) allows the head of council to provide written approval of the by-law (decision not to veto the by-law).

I, Tracey Bailey, Mayor of the Municipality of Lakeshore, hereby approve the following by-law adopted by Council at the August 11, 2026 meeting:

1. By-law 45-2026, Being a By-law to amend By-law 2-2012, Zoning By-law for the Municipality of Lakeshore (ZBA-07-2026);
2. By-law 49-2026, Being a By-law to Authorize an Agreement with M & M Concessions;
3. By-law 50-2026, Being a By-law to confirm the Proceedings of the July 14, 2026 Council Meeting; and
4. By-law 52-2026, Being a By-law to Establish the Role of Chief Administrative Officer for the Municipality of Lakeshore.
