The Township of Manitouwadge's 2026 Municipal Election will use Internet Voting, providing eligible voters with a convenient, secure, and accessible way to cast their ballot from anywhere during the voting period.

A Voter Information Letter will be mailed to eligible voters before the voting period begins. This letter will contain important instructions and the information needed to access the online voting system once voting opens.

HOW TO VOTE INTERNET VOTING



01

VISIT THE WEBSITE

Visit the website provided in your Voter Information Letter by entering the address in the bar at the top of your internet browser (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, etc.).

02

ENTER YOUR PIN & BIRTHDATE

Enter the Personal Identification Number (PIN) provided in your Voter Information Letter without spaces and enter your birthdate.



HAVING TROUBLE LOGGING IN?

An error message may indicate that your PIN or date of birth does not match the information on file. If you need assistance, call 807-826-3227 ext. 231 or visit the Municipal Office in person.

MAKE YOUR SELECTIONS

Follow the on-screen instructions and select your preferred candidates for each office on the ballot.

04

REVIEW AND SUBMIT YOUR BALLOT

Carefully review your selections. Once you are satisfied, click Submit to place your vote in the secure electronic ballot box.

05

SAVE YOUR CONFIRMATION

After your ballot has been successfully submitted, a confirmation screen will appear. You may print or take a screenshot of this confirmation for your records.



Important: Your confirmation will verify that your vote was cast successfully, but it will not display who you voted for, ensuring the secrecy of your ballot.
