Equipment Operator – Full Time

The Township of Mapleton is accepting applications for a full-time equipment operator to perform a variety of duties associated with road construction and maintenance activities, including operating a variety of construction and maintenance equipment, performing labourer activities, operating snowplow equipment on winter shifts. This position is based on a 42-hour work week and offers an hourly range of \$32.68 - \$36.78.

SPECIFIC DUTIES INCLUDE:

- Loose top maintenance, cold/hot mix repairs and patching
- Roadside and Bridge maintenance
- Tree removal, planting and trimming
- Maintaining culverts and ditches
- Construction work – including sign installation and maintenance, guidepost repairs
- Winter Control – plowing, sanding/salting, snow removal, winter damage repairs
- Equipment Maintenance – maintain large and small equipment (mechanical, welding, fabricating, painting, cleaning)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

The successful candidate will possess a Grade 12 diploma or equivalent and have working knowledge of the operation of a variety of light trucks, snowplow, agricultural and construction equipment.
