Dominion Booster Pumping Station Upgrades

THE PROJECT

The Town is undertaking key upgrades to the municipal water distribution system to ensure the continued delivery of safe, reliable service to residents and businesses. As part of this work, the **Dominion Booster Pump Station**, located at **755 Dominion Avenue** (between Seventh Street and Eighth Street), will be replaced.

The project includes the construction of a **new pump station building at the existing site** and associated **utility connections** (generally within the yellow hatched area) such as new watermain required to support long-term system performance.



During construction, residents may notice periodic activity on or around the site. Every effort will be made to minimize disruption; however, temporary increases in noise, construction traffic, and brief localized traffic slow-downs along the two-way residential road may occur. Water service interruptions are not anticipated, and any required planned interruptions will be communicated in advance. Construction is anticipated to primarily occur between summer 2026 and summer 2027.
