

BY-LAW NO. 23-2007

PARKLAND COUNTY

A BY-LAW OF PARKLAND COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND LEASING OF A PORTION OF PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of Parkland County deems it expedient to provide for a by-law for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter leasing of same, and

WHEREAS, notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

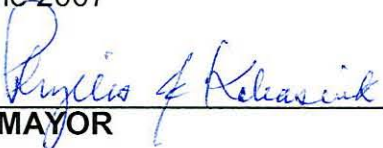
WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by this By-law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of PARKLAND COUNTY in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of leasing of the following described highways, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation:

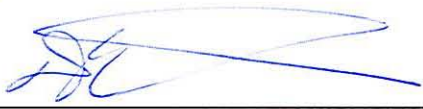
All of Meyer Road as shown on Road Plan 042 1798

Portion of South East Quarter of Section Four (4), Township Fifty Three (53), Range Twenty six (26), West of the Fourth Meridian

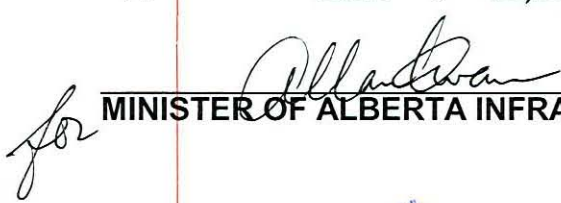
