

OUTDOOR PRESCHOOL



- The Treehouse Forest Preschool is a 3-year pilot program in Woodhaven Regional Park.
- Partnership with The Clubhouse Child Care Center.
- Much needed child care spaces for our community.
- More opportunities for public education in our parks.

BENEFITS TO CHILDREN



- Freedom to explore in nature helps children develop confidence, critical thinking and leadership skills.
- Outside learning helps children be healthier, happier, and calmer.
- Sensory-rich outdoor spaces enhance their physical, cognitive and social skills.
- Valuable, unstructured play.

DAY-TO-DAY ACTIVITIES



- Maximum of 20 children in two sessions per day with a high adult-child ratio.
- Programs running Monday through Friday from 9am to 3pm.
- All activities are outdoors with limited indoor access to the Raymer cabin.
- Certified staff will be on site daily.

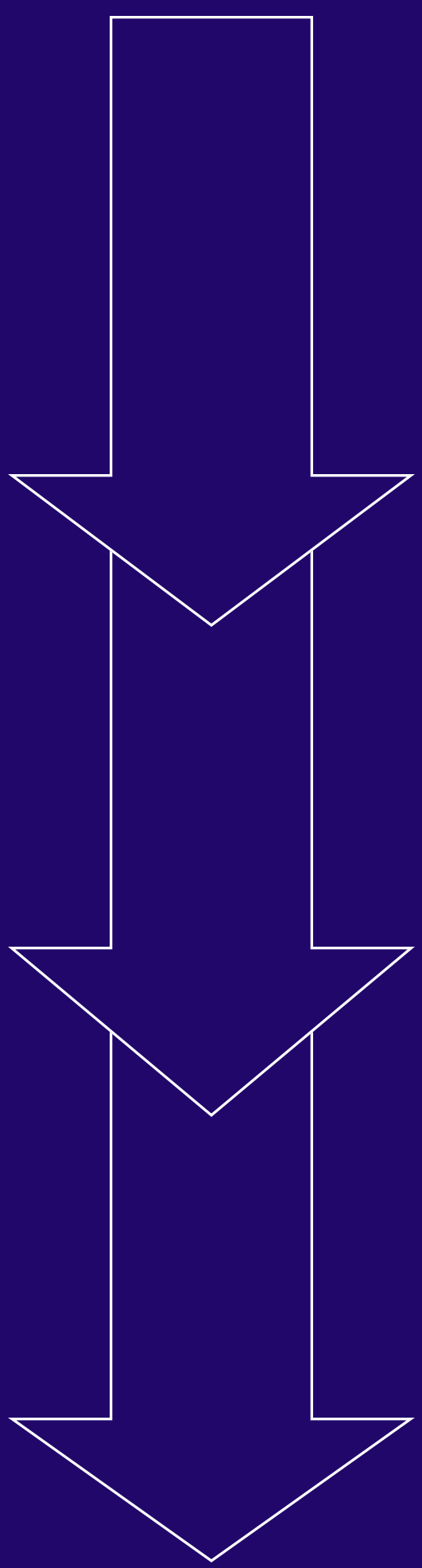
