- WHEREAS** the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo is committed to advancing reconciliation through strengthened relationships based on the recognition of rights, respect, and friendship; and
- WHEREAS** June 21 is a day to inspire Canadians to actively participate in community events and learning opportunities to increase personal understanding of the true history of the region and to advance truth and reconciliation in Wood Buffalo.
