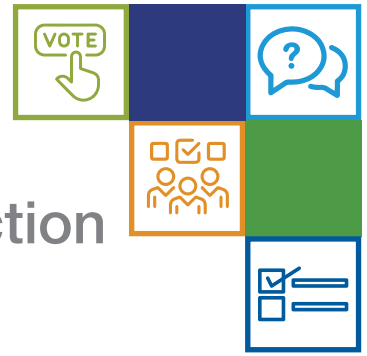

Municipal and School Board Election

October 26, 2026

Are you on the Voters' List?

You are eligible to vote in the Township of Springwater municipal election if you are:

- a resident of Springwater, or an owner or tenant of property in Springwater, or the spouse of an owner or tenant;
- a Canadian citizen; and
- 18 years of age or older on Election Day, October 26, 2026.

We all play a role in ensuring a fair electoral system. It is each elector's responsibility to make sure their information is up to date and accurately reflected for electoral purposes. Use the tool on our website (springwater.voterservices.ca) to check if you are on the Voters' List. Eligible voters can also use this tool to add their name or update their information.

How to Vote

Voters will be able to cast their ballot in person at a voting location or remotely by internet. Voters will receive a Voter Information Letter by mail in late September 2026. The Voter Information Letter will include detailed instructions on how to cast your ballot.

Two Convenient Ways to Cast Your Ballot:

Vote In-Person:

Voters are provided the option to vote in-person, electronically, at any voting location on Election Day and during the advanced voting period. Voting location dates and times will be made available in September 2026 and included in your Voter Information Letter.

Vote Anywhere by Internet:

Electors can vote by internet using a computer, tablet or mobile device. Detailed instructions, including the voting portal website, voting PIN and other important information will be included in your Voter Information Letter, which will be mailed in late September. To enhance the security of online voting, electors will be required to complete an identity verification process.

Remote voting will open at **10:00 a.m. on Friday, October 16, 2026**, and will close at **8:00 p.m. on Monday, October 26, 2026**.

Ward Boundaries

On October 1, 2025, Council approved changes to the Township's ward boundaries to be effective as of the new term of council. Electors will be voting for representation based on these new wards. Visit our ward boundary map at www.springwater.ca/Elections and choose Find My Ward.

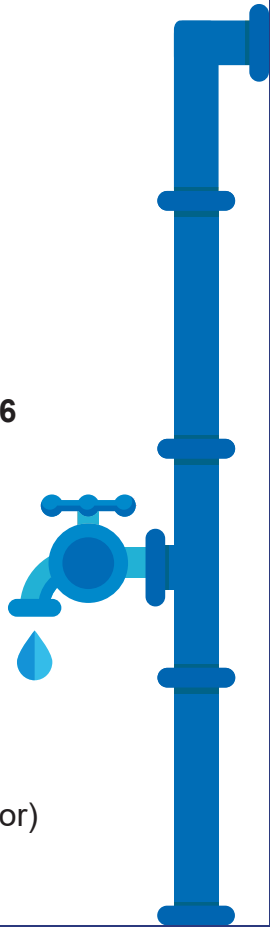

Don't Forget to Pay

Water and wastewater bills are issued on a quarterly basis for residential accounts and monthly for multi-residential and commercial accounts.

Residential water meters were read in June by the Township's third-party contractor, and bills were mailed to residents in July.

Water and wastewater bill payments are due at the end of August.

Please ensure your water and/or wastewater bill is paid by the due date.

A late payment charge of 1.25% per month will be added to overdue balances. If an account remains unpaid, water service may be disconnected.

If you do not receive a bill, you are still responsible for ensuring payment is made on time and for any applicable late payment charges.

Learn Before You Burn

Before you have a fire, be sure to confirm what the fire danger rating is set at and what is permitted:

Low: Open-air burning is permitted by permit only. Residents must follow all conditions outlined in their burn permit and burn responsibly at all times.

Moderate: Open-air burning is permitted by permit only. Residents are reminded to use extra caution, monitor weather conditions, and ensure all permit requirements are followed.

High: Open-air burning is permitted by permit only. Residents are urged to be extremely cautious and avoid burning during windy or unsafe conditions, even if they have a valid permit.

Extreme: When a fire ban is in effect, all open-air burning is prohibited. Burn permits are suspended until the ban is lifted.
