Sepsis is a life threatening illness caused by a body's over reaction to an infection, that can affect anyone and, if not recognized and treated promptly may lead to shock, organ failure, death or long-term disabilities;

AND WHEREAS

Early signs of sepsis may include fever, rapid heartbeat, and fast breathing that can affect vital organs;

AND WHEREAS

Many individuals diagnosed with sepsis require intensive care, placing considerable burden on the provincial health system;

AND WHEREAS

The Town recognizes that this illness has impacted many within our own community;

AND WHEREAS

The Town recognizes the ongoing efforts of organizations and researchers dedicated to advancing the understanding of sepsis, and improving its prevention, early detection and treatment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that, on behalf of Council, I Pat Fule, mayor of the Town of Strathmore, do hereby proclaim September 13, 2026 as World Sepsis Day in the Town of Strathmore.
