City of Temiskaming Shores Municipal Elections 2026 Notice of the Voters' List and the Commencement of the Revision Period – September 1, 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that the Voters List containing the names of those persons eligible to vote in the City of Temiskaming Shores 2026 Municipal and School Board Election, will be available at the Municipal Office, 325 Farr Drive, Haileybury, Ontario, commencing on Tuesday, September 1, 2026.

A person may make an application to the Clerk requesting their name be added to or removed from the Voters' List, or that information on the Voters' List relating to them be amended by completing and filing the prescribed form available at: **The Office of the Clerk, City of Temiskaming Shores, 325 Farr Drive, P.O Box 2050, Haileybury, ON P0J 1K0**, during regular office hours between September 1, 2026 to October 23, 2026, and to the close of voting on October 26, 2026. The application shall be in writing and shall be filed in person, or by mail. Proof of identity and residence as prescribed in [O. Reg. 304/13](#) will be required of the applicant. If the applicant does not appear in person, a certified copy showing proof of ID and proof of residence/occupancy is required to accompany the application.

Voting Method:

The 2026 Municipal Election will be conducted using alternative voting (eVoting) methods. Eligible electors may vote securely by **Internet** or **Telephone**. Each eligible elector on the Voters' List will receive a **Voter Information Letter (VIL)** containing: a unique Personal Identification Number (PIN); the voting website address, and the telephone voting number. To access their ballot, electors will be required to enter their PIN and verify their identity by providing their date of birth.

Voting Period:

Internet and telephone voting will open at **9:00 a.m. on Friday, October 16, 2026**, and close at **8:00 p.m. on Monday, October 26, 2026**.

Eligible electors may vote **24 hours a day** throughout the voting period until the close of voting. Electors are encouraged to vote early in the event they require assistance before voting closes.

Voter Locations and Help:

Election staff will be available at the dates, times, and locations listed below to assist eligible electors who: need to be added to the Voters' List; have lost or did not receive their Voter Information Letter (VIL); or require assistance with the Internet or telephone voting process.

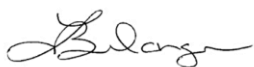

A person is entitled to vote in a municipal election if he or she on Voting Day,

- resides in the local municipality, or is the Owner or Tenant of land in the municipality, or the spouse of such Owner or Tenant; and
- is a Canadian citizen, and
- is at least 18 years old, and
- is not prohibited from voting by law.
