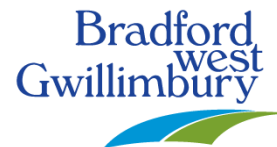

Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (s. 23)



NOTICE is hereby given, that the list of all persons eligible to vote in the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury for the 2026 Municipal Election (the "Voters' List") has been prepared and is available for inspection at the Administrative Office, 100 Dissette Street, Units 7 & 8 as of Tuesday, September 1, 2026.

ALL ELECTORS should ensure that they are on the Voters' List and that their name and relevant information is correctly shown. Electors can check this information by:

- visiting the voter registration portal on the Town's website at www.townofbwg.com/election under 'Are you on the Voters' List?';
- calling 905-775-5366 ext. VOTE (8683);
- attending the Town's Administrative Office at 100 Dissette Street, Units 7 & 8 during the regular office hours of Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

APPLICATIONS FOR REVISIONS to the Voters' List will be accepted during the period from **September 1, 2026 to October 26, 2026**. An elector may add or revise their information on the Voters' List online by using the voter registration portal at www.townofbwg.com/election or in-person by attending the Town's Administrative Office and completing an Application to Amend Voters' List [EL15] and providing proof of identity and residence as prescribed in O. Reg. 304/13.

QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTORS

A person is entitled to be a voter in the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, if they are on voting day:

- ✓ a resident in the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, or the owner or tenant of land there, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- ✓ a Canadian citizen; and
- ✓ at least 18 years old, and
- ✓ not otherwise prohibited from voting by law.
