

## **Wetaskiwin Region Resident Tourism Survey: Prize Draw Rules**

**Sponsor:** City of Wetaskiwin, in partnership with the County of Wetaskiwin and JEDI.

**Contest period:** The contest opens September 24, 2026 at 12:00PM and closes October 15, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. MT.

**Eligibility:** Open to residents of the City of Wetaskiwin, the County of Wetaskiwin and Maskwacis who are 18 years of age or older. Employees of the City of Wetaskiwin, the County of Wetaskiwin and JEDI, and members of their immediate households, are not eligible.

**How to enter:** Complete the Wetaskiwin Region Resident Tourism Survey, choose “Yes” to enter the draw, and complete the entry questions, including a valid email address. No purchase is necessary. Limit of one entry per person. Entering the draw is optional; survey answers are kept confidential and reported only in summary.

**Prize:** One (1) prize package with an approximate total retail value of \$150 CAD, made up of one Reynolds Museum family pass, one Huckleberry’s gift card, and a City of Wetaskiwin swag package. The prize must be accepted as awarded and cannot be exchanged for cash.

**Draw:** One winner will be randomly selected from all eligible entries on October 19, 2026, at Wetaskiwin, AB. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

**Winner notification:** The selected entrant will be contacted by email within [2] business days and must correctly answer the skill-testing question. If the selected entrant cannot be reached within [5] business days, an alternate winner will be drawn.

**Publicity:** With the winner’s consent, the winner’s first name and community may be announced publicly.
